VUI where you say all the expiring dates and it monitors and lets you know when things are going bad A mobile app which can store each items expire date and arrange them by time A solution that tracks expiry dates of items purchased and sends reminder at preset times

Having a scanning function on a digital app to note what groceries have been purchased in a household.

Integrating VUI is great for accessibility and integration for apps like Siri and Alexa to self populate information stored.

Based on the expiring food it can suggest recipe/meals to create

Provide storage tips with the expiry date possibly track the expiry dates of the scanned items as well

VUI can also be used to track items as it is being used so that you know what you have left per time

Custom recipe "playlists/cookb ooks" can be made if a user has an account.

Tracks when certain items are going bad and reminds you to freeze or preserve it longer

An anonymous platform where you can sponsor a family and provide them food for x period of time Like unmanned supermarket, user can self check out freely by scanning an encrypted card User can generate random anonymous profile for a message board, the identity is only disclosed in private at the point of receiving support Users can perhaps decide on a fun avator to represent their profile.

There can be an option to volunteer on this platform as well to allow donors/ and families in need to feel a part of the process.

Resource contact kiosks in low income neighbourhoods that they can register for support Online anoymous platform list all the additional resources and arranged by location so that users can easily find the nearest one

Discrete packaging for additional resources Maybe the packaging can be similar to a subscription box so its also environmentally friendly and easy to carry.

Pick up can be in a government office, waimart booth or a known area that does not disclose that its for these recipients so they blend in.

an anonymous hotline that they can call and have food delivered or pick it up Make up the packages like online shopping items', ie. use cardboard boxes the boxes can be mailed to the people so they don't have to leave their homes

Anonymously sign up for help and be contacted by a food 'donor'

Make the pick up process like pick up shipments in Canada Post spot These hotspots would be in low income areas that don't have grocery stores in close access
